Reason for denial _____

In order to minimize danger and/or inconvenience to businesses and resident, the following procedures will be followed by the Contractor:

- 1. At least three days prior to blast nearby businesses/residence will be made aware of blast schedule.**
- 2. One half hour before the blast nearby businesses and residents will be notified.**
- 3. Prior to any blasting, representatives of the Contractor will visually check the area around the site for pedestrians and warn them of the impending blast.**
- 4. Any vehicles in the area will be moved to a safe area.**
- 5. Vehicular traffic on nearby roads will be halted.**
- 6. A horn will be sounded one minute before the blast and again 30 seconds before the blast.**
