## History of Service


Organized by a group of concerned citizens in 1952, the East Whiteland Township Volunteer Fire Association, Chester County Station 5, is celebrating 60 years of service to the community.

The volunteer fire company provides Fire, Rescue, Basic Life Support, EMS, HazMat, and Fire-Police services for East Whiteland Township and parts of Charlestown Township. The company is also the primary EMS provider to parts of neighboring West Whiteland Township. In addition to residential neighborhoods, the "first in" coverage area includes Routes 29, 202, 30, 401, the PA Turnpike, Immaculata University and numerous business parks and retail centers.

- Serving our community 24/7, 365 days a year
- On average: 900 Ambulance calls and 700 Fire calls per year

## The Need

- Built in 1958 the existing station is too small to house fire and ambulance apparatus, equipment, and support functions.
- The existing firehouse is not centrally located, negatively impacting response times.
- The firehouse does not meet building, fire or ADA codes.
- The deteriorating condition of the facility and the outdated nature of the structure hinders 24/7 capabilities, equipment maintenance, training, community outreach and ongoing recruitment of volunteers.
