All residents who would like to dispose of items containing Freon, (i.e. - refrigerator, freezer, air conditioner, and dehumidifier) must call the Township before Tuesday, October 26th, 2010 at 610-648-0600 extension 210 or email diovine@eastwhiteland.org to schedule a home pick-up.

All other acceptable items must be placed at the curb by 7:00 AM on Wednesday, October 27th to be picked up by the Township Public Works Department. We will continue our pickup each day until we have covered the entire Township, which may take up to 3 days. Please do not put out items that could be picked up by your regular trash hauler. This is for large items only.

Residents may take acceptable items to the Public Works Garage at 158 Planebrook Road on Saturday, October 30th, 2010. A Township employee will be available to provide assistance.
