Use of Parks and Facilities During Yellow Phase of Reopening

Now that Chester County is in the Yellow Phase and Governor Wolf's Stay-At-Home Order has expired, East Whiteland Township has updated the rules for the use of parks and facilities in the Township. Based on the recommendations from the PA State Health Department, the CDC and PA Recreation and Park Society, please adhere to the following when visiting Township parks and facilities:

- Playgrounds will remain closed as indicated with caution tape. If you, or someone else, removes the caution tape, using any of the playgrounds is **at your own risk** as they are not being sanitized.
- Tennis Courts will remain closed. They are being resurfaced and being supplied with new nets. Once this work is done, the courts will be open for use (no organized play yet).
- Basketball courts will remain closed. (The Down East Park court is scheduled to be repaved with new posts and back boards to be installed by the end of July or sooner).
- Soccer Fields will remain closed for organized play. Families are permitted to enjoy the fields while practicing social distancing from other families.
- Baseball fields will remain closed for organized/league play or practice.
- Pavilions will remain closed and no reservations are currently being taken.
- Restrooms will remain closed during Yellow Phase.

Chester County hopes to move to Green Phase by the end of June. We will revisit these rules at that time.
