Township Saves \$282,000 With Bond Sale

The Township recently sold \$6 million in General Obligation bonds with the proceeds being used to retire existing debt.

The bonds were sold with a lower interest rate than the existing outstanding bonds. The Township will save \$282,000 in interest as a result of the sale.

The bonds were assigned an Aa1 rating, which is the second highest rating assigned by Moody's, which managed the sale. The rating reflects the Township's high credit.

The Moody's report states: "The Aa1 reflects the township's large tax base with above average wealth and strong financial position despite moderate reliance on economically sensitive revenues. The rating also incorporates the township's average debt burden and below-average pension liabilities."

CVS/pharmacy Grant To Fund Drug Collection Bin

The Police Department has obtained a grant from CVS/pharmacy that will fund a drug collection bin at the department.

The bin will be located in the lobby of the Police Department. It will provide residents with a safe and environmentally responsible way to dispose of unwanted, unused or expired medication, including controlled substances. The bin is intended to reduce the amount of unneeded medicine in residents' homes and decrease prescription drug abuse.

Quarry Rescue A Model Of Teamwork

Members of several emergency response teams, including the East Whiteland Fire Company, recently joined to rescue the driver of a truck that had fallen into the Catanach Quarry off Morehall Road.

The driver of the truck became trapped after the vehicle went into the quarry on October 31. Members of the fire company and the Chester County Rescue Task Force deployed about 150 feet over the edge of the quarry to rescue the driver, who was taken to Paoli Hospital for evaluation.

Participating in the rescue were the East Whiteland Fire Company, Chester County fire dispatchers, Able Brothers Towing and the Chester County Rescue Task Force.
