### Trail Safety

A friendly reminder of some safety tips for when you're enjoying these summer days on the trails!

1. Children should stay in front of and within view of their parents
2. Always walk/ride to the right side of the trail.
3. Give verbal warning when passing others.
4. Yield to pedestrians.
5. Follow traffic signals and remember to push the signal button at Route 401 so cars know you intend to cross the road.

2. Stay relaxed, avoid eye contact and ignore rude gestures;
3. Don't block the passing lane if you are driving slower than most of the traffic.
